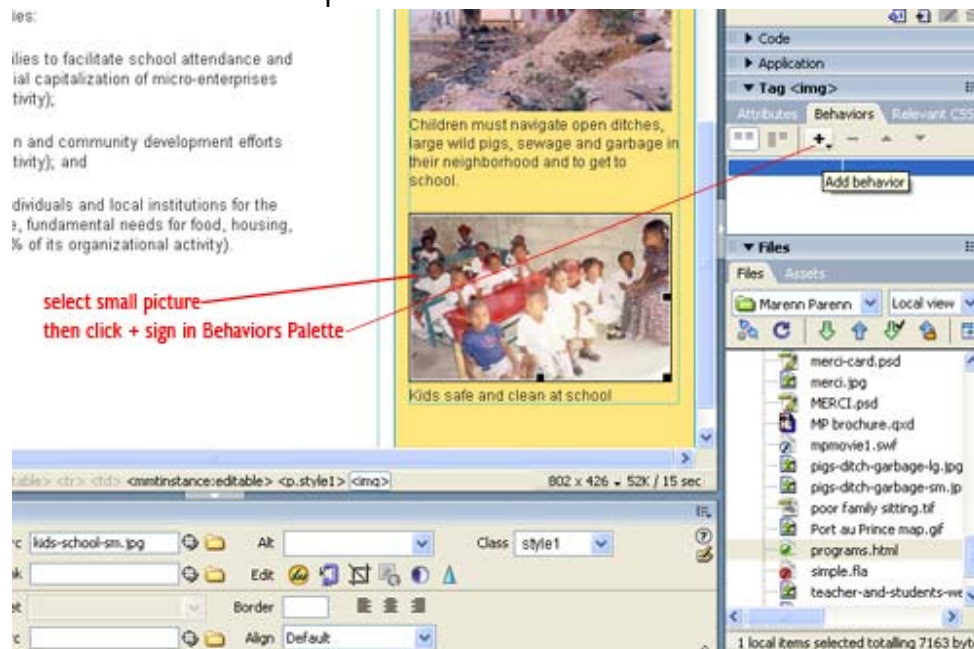


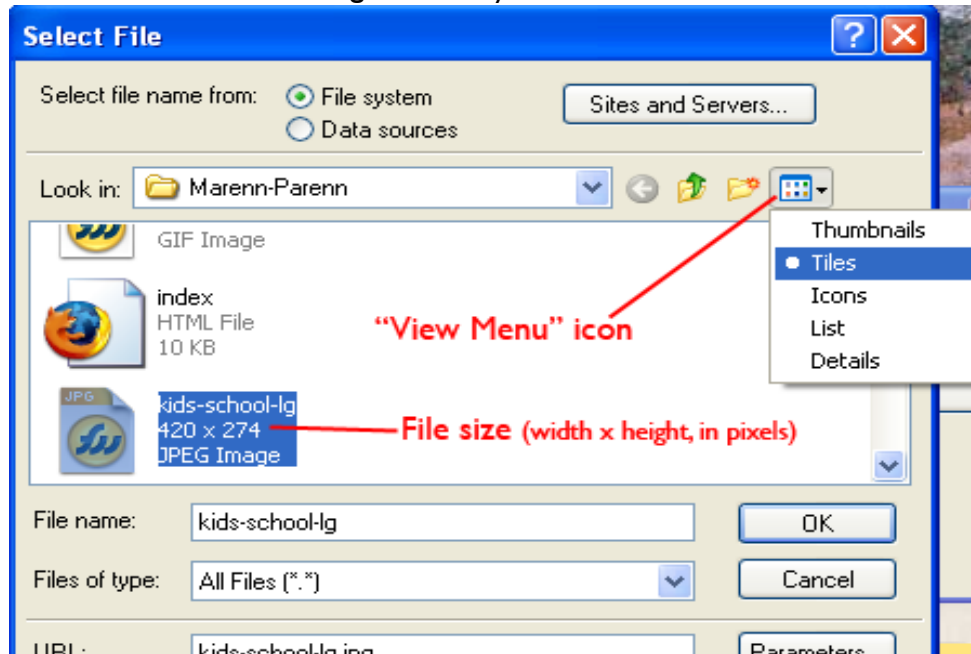
How to Create a Pop Up Window

(on the web when you click on a little picture a big one pops up in a new browser window) (yes, you can also make click on a little picture and have a web page pop up)

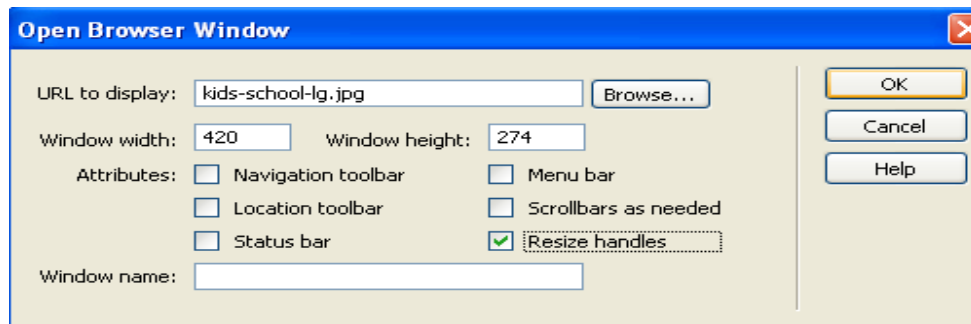
1. Format a graphic that is small enough to fit easily on a website. Remember 72 pixels = 1 inch, so somewhere between 72 pixels and 250 is good.
2. Format a graphic that is full size (640 x 480 is good, or 480 x 360 is good). Remember, people with 14" monitors can only see graphics 740 pixels wide or smaller. So, 640 is a good maximum width for a graphic. 400 pixels is a good maximum height (unless you are a higher end, artsy or portfolio kind of site).
3. Open Dreamweaver MX 2004. Go to the Files Palette (if not open in bottom left corner, go WINDOW → FILES to open). Make sure your site is the one selected/active. If not, choose it. If it is not in the list, go SITE → MANAGE SITES and add it.
4. Then in the Files Palette select (click just one time to highlight it) the page you want to work on. Click the Green Arrow pointing downward to download the latest version of the file. If not, you may be working on an old file. When the newest file is downloaded, double-click on it to open it.
5. Go INSERT → IMAGE and select the small image. It will appear.
6. Open up the Behaviors Window. It won't be open already probably, go to WINDOW → BEHAVIORS to open up.
7. Highlight the small picture, on the Behaviors Palette click the Plus sign + to Add a Behavior. Choose "Open Browser Window."



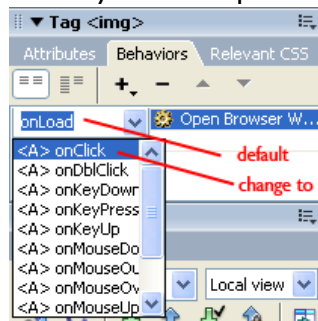
- When the next window appears select your large image, be sure to note the file size dimensions. Don't see file size dimensions? Click on the "View Menu" icon and scroll to "Tiles" setting and then you will!



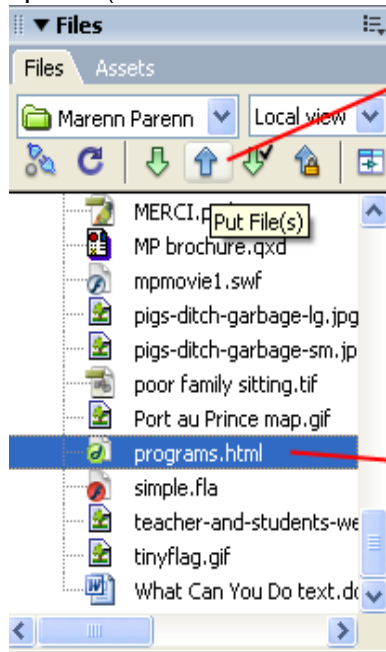
- Then enter them below and also choose "Resize Handles." Feel free to experiment with different settings on different pictures and see what you like. Don't bother to fill out a window name. Click OK.



- Lastly, the Behaviors Palette defaults to "onLoad." Change this to "onClick." Do this by clicking on the word "onLoad." A pop-up menu appears. Scroll all the way to the top and click on/select "onClick."



11. On the Menu Bar at the top go FILE → SAVE (if it gives you a weird message about templates, go FILE → SAVE AS).
12. Then, on the bottom right area of your screen, go back to the Files Palette. Highlight the name of the file in the Files Palette. Click the Blue Arrow pointing upward to load. Say “yes” when it asks to “Load dependent files?” Lastly, it usually does not load the big picture for some glitch. Highlight this file and upload (click the Blue Arrow pointing up) it as well.



2. then click blue arrow pointing up to "Put File" on web host (change online)

1. click one time to highlight file you just changed

13. Go online and test it out!



clicking the small image makes the large image "pop up"
